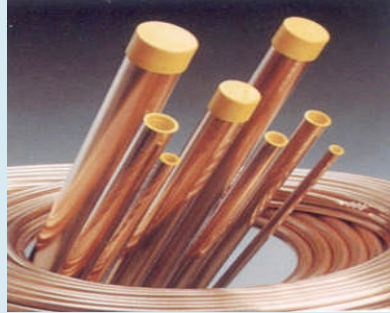


Do you or your staff install Split System Air-Conditioning ?

A new national licensing system for technicians and businesses involved in the refrigeration and air-conditioning industry came in to effect from 1st July 2005.

This new licensing system replaces the old state and territory licensing systems with one nationally recognised license.

MEM 20105 Certificate II in Engineering, Split Systems Air Conditioning, the required qualification to gain the new National Air Conditioning Refrigerant Handling License through Skills Recognition!

What is Skills Recognition?

A form of assessment that recognises your education, training, life and work experiences you have acquired which can then be transferred to a Nationally Accredited Qualification. Skills Recognition can assist in obtaining employment, gaining a promotion or can be used as a pathway into further studies.

WT35 - MEM 20105 Certificate II in Engineering, Split Systems Air Conditioning

Individuals who attain MEM20105 Certificate II in Engineering will be considered eligible to obtain a **Restricted Split System Air conditioning Installation and Decommissioning Licence**. The following units of competency are required for the successful completion of the qualification

- **MEM13014A** Apply principles of occupational health and safety in the work environment
- **MEM14004A** Plan to undertake a routine task
- **MEM15002A** Apply quality systems
- **MEM15024A** Apply quality procedures
- **MEM16007A** Work with others in a manufacturing, engineering or related environment
- **MEM05006B** Perform brazing and/or silver soldering
- **MEM09002B** Interpret technical drawing
- **MEM10013A** Install split air conditioning systems and associated pipe work
- **MEM12023A** Perform engineering measurements
- **MEM14005A** Plan a complete activity
- **MEM18001C** Use hand tools
- **MEM18002B** Use power tools/hand held operations
- **MEM18055B** Dismantle replace and assemble engineering components
- **MEM18084A** Commission and decommission split air conditioning systems
